CPEA “Educator of the Year”

Since 1978, the Canton Professional Educators’ Association has chosen an “Educator of the Year.” This award is based on classroom performance, dedication to public education, community service, honors and awards, and extra-curricular school activities. The teacher is nominated and selected by colleagues.

In this ***Communique***, we would like to introduce you to Ms. Ora Strain, our 2014-2015 CPEA Educator of the Year.

To quote from her nomination letter:

Ora Strain is our most recent award winner. She retired at the end of the 2014-2015 school year, serving in the position of a Title I Teacher at Allen Elementary School. Ora taught for 27 years, all in Canton City Schools, and was a member OEA, NEA, and CPEA where she held a position on our Executive Leadership Team. She served our country in the U.S. Army for three years of active duty and thirteen years in the Reserves, and holds positions on the Board of the NAACP and Leila Green Alliance of Black School Educators.

Ora has received awards from the Martha Jennings Program, the Stark County Character Counts Program, the Ohio Lottery Teacher Character of the Month, and the Martin Luther King, Jr. Award for 2015.
